ORDINANCE NO. 13-013

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VEHICULAR PARKING DURING
DESIGNATED STREET SWEEPING TIMES**

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Village's Public Works Department sweeps the public streets of the Village of Dolton; and

WHEREAS, the presence of parked cars on the streets where street sweeping is to take place interferes with the cleaning of the streets; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that it is reasonable to prohibit parking on public streets during street sweeping times; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have further determined that it is appropriate to provide prior notice as to the dates and times of street sweeping;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolton, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Municipal Code Amended.

Section 6-4-2-F of the Village of Dolton Municipal Code is deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the following:

Section F: Parking Prohibited During Street Sweeping Activities.

- A. No person shall park a motor vehicle on any public street at such date and time that the street has been designated by the Village for street sweeping activities.

- B. Any person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined an amount not less than ONE HUNDRED & 00/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 2: Authorization.

The Village Administrator and Public Works Department are hereby authorized and directed to erect appropriate signage throughout the Village in order to provide adequate notice of the dates and times of street sweeping.

SECTION 5: Full Force and Effect.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
