ORDINANCE NO. 13-016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DOLTON AMENDING TITLE 6, ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES," CHAPTER 5, "TRAFFIC SCHEDULES" AT SECTION 6-5-4-1, "STOP SIGNS" OF THE 1988 MUNICIPAL CODE OF DOLTON (ADDITION OF 2-WAY STOP AT IRVING AVENUE AND GREENWOOD ROAD CONVERTING INTERSECTION TO FOUR-WAY STOP)

The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolton, Cook County, Illinois, make the following findings of fact:

1. That currently there is a two-way stop north bound and south bound at Irving Avenue and Greenwood Road in the Village of Dolton.
2. That the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that the posting of stop signs southeast bound and northwest bound at Irving Avenue and Greenwood Road is of an urgent nature in order to reduce hazardous traffic conditions, and is also necessary in order to improve traffic conditions and pedestrian safety near Dolton Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolton, Cook County, Illinois, being a home rule unit of government, that the 1988 Municipal Code of the Village of Dolton be amended at TITLE 6, "MOTOR VEHICLES," at Chapter 5, "Traffic Schedules," at Section 6-5-4-1, "Stop Signs," as follows:

SECTION 1: To incorporate the posting of a two-way stop sign, as follows:

Southeast bound and Northwest bound on Greenwood Road at Irving Avenue, rendering the intersection a 4-way stop.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
