**Public Works Productivity Report for November 2021** 

Public Works has been making tremendous progress in cleaning up the village. There is still a lot to improve in the village and we are working diligently to get the job done.

For the month of November: we have trimmed 19 trees, cut down 8 large trees, completed 3 b-box repairs, repaired 4 water main breaks, installed 9 stop signs, and 4 street signs. We have also repaired numerous potholes and completed numerous loader pick-ups from fly dumping throughout the village. We are working with Meade Lighting making repairs to light poles and wiring infrastructure. We have completed restoration on 21 properties, cut grass and weed whipped 4 properties, 1 vacant property and 2 vacant lots. We have completed numerous loader pick-ups from fly dumping. We have installed a hydrant on Engle, installed 2 control valves and repaired a sanitary sewer on 138<sup>th</sup> Forest. Several streets have been paved including: Park, 144<sup>th</sup> from Chicago Rd to Greenwood, Shepard Dr, State St and University.

Public Works mechanics performed no jobs to the Fire Department vehicles, 2 jobs to the Housing Department vehicles, 4 jobs to the Police Department vehicles and 16 jobs to the Public Works vehicles along with miscellaneous jobs that have come into the shop.
