CHECKLIST FOR PERMITS (GENERAL/ELECTRICAL/PLUMBING)

Should I apply?

- All work conducted within village limits must have an active permit on the premise.
 - Electrical work needs an **Electrical Permit**, plumbing work needs a **Plumbing Permit**, and all other work would need a **General Permit**.
 - The **only exceptions** are painting, patching, and installing peel and stick flooring (done by homeowner **NOT A CONTRACTOR**).

How to apply?

- Please complete the <u>corresponding Permit Application</u>. Available here: https://vodolton.org/housing-permits/.
- General/Electrical/Plumbing permits can only to be pulled by a LICENSED CONTRACTOR
 - If the contractor is not license they can apply for one here
 - Contractor's license is \$350 for a full year (partial year is \$175)
 - All licensed Plumbers are exempt from this fee.
- Application must be submitted along with a copy of the scope of work/letter of intent.
 - New fencing permit also requires a copy of the Plat of Survey.
- All **Electrical** and **Plumbing** permits can **ONLY** be pulled that respective tradesman.
- Homeowners can apply for Homeowners' Permit for any minor repairs that the homeowner themselves are conducting.
 - **Homeowner** must reside in property.
 - **General** work is the only type of work that can done under this type of permit.
 - Permit and work must be done by the homeowner **NO ONE ELSE**
 - Any contractor caught working onsite of a premise under a Homeowners' Permit can result in the permit being **REVOKED** and citations issued.
- Permits can take <u>up to five business days</u> for issuance. Once ready, we will call the number on the application for pick-up.
- Cost of the permit is dependent on the cost of the job. For example:
 - **General** work costing less than \$5,000 would cost \$250 (\$150 for permit / \$100 for inspection). Price increases incrementally every \$5,000.
 - Electrical and Plumbing permits are calculated at 6% of the cost of the job (no less than \$100) and inspection fee is \$50.



Do I need an inspection?

- Once work is complete, please contact the village to schedule the inspection. Scheduling can be done at (708) 201-3296 or permits@vodolton.org.
- Must call 24 hours in advance to schedule. (**No same day inspections**)
- Rough inspections are required before closing any walls, ceilings, etc. containing Electrical and/or Plumbing.
 - All concrete framework requires a **Pre-Pour** inspection.
 - New fencing requires a **Post Hole** inspection.
 - New roofing requires an **Ice and Water Shield** inspection (no final)
- All remaining work must have Final inspections upon completion.
