 - A. Discussion regarding the distribution of the \$1.5 million grant received from American Rescue Act Plan for COVID 19 relief. Mayor Henyard gave an update on fund distributions for residents, businesses and water meters and repair of roofs and windows. Paperwork will go out in February. There are 3 to 5 vendors who will bid on the roofs and windows.
 - B. Discussion for the approval of the 2022 Digital Water Installation Project. Keith Freeman and Jimmie Vassalli are working on this project. Secure funding from IPA will be discussed at the Finance Committee Meeting.
 - C. Status of Severance pay approved by the Board of Trustees. Mayor Henyard stated she is still waiting on a legal opinion. Trustee House requested a legal opinion at the meeting. Attorney Vasselli stated there were changes in the Illinois law regarding severance payments. There was no state statue. Board could vote yes or no. He also stated he would give a reply no later than Monday. Trustee House stated turn-around time was too slow and the board needed clarity.
