ORDINANCE NO. 15-021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, SUBSECTION 4-9-8F, "OPEN
DUMPING, FLY DUMPING" OF THE DOLTON VILLAGE CODE
(FINES AND REWARD)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF DOLTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, in the exercise of its home rule
authority as follows:

SECTION 1: Amendment. Title 4, "Public Health and Safety", Chapter 9, "Garbage and
Waste", Subsection 4-9-8F, "Open Dumping, Fly Dumping" is hereby amended to reflect the
following changes in fees and adding a resident reward as follows (Note: Changes in bold face):

3. Any person found to have violated any provision of Section 4-9-8F shall be
subject to the following penalty(s):

A. Fine. A penalty of **\$2,500.00** for each violation of each such
provision, except that the penalty amount imposed will be \$3,000.00 for each
violation of any provision of Section 4-9-8F that is violator's second or
subsequent adjudicated violation of any provision of Section 4-9-8F. The
recipient of a citation may contest the issuance of the citation and is entitled
to a hearing on the citation pursuant to the provisions of Title 13, Municipal
Code Violations, Chapter 1, Administrative Adjudication and Enforcement of
Code Violations. Failure of the recipient of the citation to appear at the court
date will constitute a default.

B. Impoundment of Vehicle. A motor vehicle that is used in violation of
this section prohibiting open dumping or "fly" dumping shall be subject to
seizure and impoundment under this section. The owner of record of such
vehicle shall be liable to the Village of Dolton for an administrative penalty
of \$1,000.00 in addition to the fees for the towing and storage of the vehicle,
and fines or penalties that may be imposed under this Section 4-9-8F.


Whenever a police officer or Village official has probable cause to believe that a vehicle is subject to seizure and impoundment pursuant to this section, a Dolton police officer shall provide for the towing of the vehicle to a facility controlled by the Village or its agents. When the vehicle is towed, the police officer shall notify the person who is found to be in control of the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation, if there is such a person, of the fact of the seizure and of the vehicle owner's right to request a preliminary hearing to be conducted under Section 6-9-4 of this Code. The provisions of Section 6-9-4 shall apply whenever a motor vehicle is seized and impounded pursuant to this section.

C. Reward. Residents who sign a formal complaint regarding fly dumping, and the complaint results in an arrest, will receive a reward of \$500.00.

SECTION 2: Repealer. Any provision of the Village Code heretofore adopted which is in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
