ORDINANCE NO. 20-004

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-4A-1-7 OF THE DOLTON VILLAGE
CODE RELATING TO VIDEO GAMBLING TERMINALS**

WHEREAS, Section 3-4A-1-7 of the Dolton Village Code, subsection B, “Video Gambling Terminals” provides: “No more than five (5) video gambling terminals may be located on any premises licensed to sell alcoholic liquors”; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly has recently amended the Illinois Video Gaming Act to increase the number of authorized video gaming terminals on a licensed establishment from five (5) terminals to six (6); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dolton have determined that amending the ordinance consistent with state law is reasonable;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DOLTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, in the exercise of its home rule authority, as follows:

SECTION 1: Amendment. Section 3-4A-1-7 of the Dolton Village Code, “Number of Licenses Issued,” is hereby amended by amending the first sentence of the second paragraph B, “Video Gambling Terminal,” to provide as follows: [Deleted language shown with a ~~strikeout~~]:

No more than ~~five (5)~~ six (6) video gambling terminals may be located on any premises licensed to sell alcoholic liquors.

SECTION 2: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
