Description

This position involves operation of light to heavy trucks and motorized equipment used for street and alley repair and other department duties. Operates various public works trucks and performs additional manual work tasks; does related work as required. This is semi-skilled work, primarily involving the operation of both single and tandem chassis trucks.

Duties/Responsibilities

Duties include the performance of manual labor tasks in connection with the operation of trucks, including snow removal and other work projects. Install signs and posts, picks up bulky waste, debris, leaves, brush and other trash. Assists in preventive maintenance on vehicles and equipment and assists in general maintenance of related facilities. Employee may also be required to perform manual labor when necessary. Work is carried out in accordance with standard departmental practices, procedures and instructions, which are given and checked by a supervisor. The work may require moderate to heavy physical effort.

Required Skills/Abilities

- Knowledge of the standards practices, methods, equipment and tools of the road and maintenance.
- Working knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Ability to work long hours, weekends, and holidays as required in inclement weather.
- Must be able to work outdoors in all environmental and weather conditions.
- Ability to establish and maintain a good working relationship with co-workers and the general public.

Qualifications

High school diploma or equivalent

At least two years related experience required.

Valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) class B with air brake endorsement. (Must provide copy of license)
