Public Works Productivity Report for October 2021

Public Works has been making tremendous progress in cleaning up the village. There is a lot to improve in the village, but there is evidence that the village is being taken care of.

For the month of October: we have trimmed 14 trees, cut down 4 large trees, completed 4 b-box repairs, repaired 1 water main break, installed 20 stop signs, 2 no parking signs, 2 handicapped signs. We have completed the removal of wood chips at 142nd Park, repaired numerous potholes throughout the village, performed 3 emergency water turn offs. We are working with Meade Lighting making repairs to light poles and wiring infrastructure. We have completed restoration on 8 properties, cut grass and weed whipped 13 properties, 9 vacant properties and 5 vacant lots. We have completed numerous loader pick-ups from fly dumping.

Public Works mechanics performed 8 jobs to the Fire Department vehicles, 1 job to the Housing Department vehicles, 5 jobs to the Police Department vehicles and 10 jobs to the Public Works vehicles along with miscellaneous jobs that have come into the shop.
