MINUTES

1. PUBLIC COMMENTS began @ 5:16pm

PRESENT: Mayor, (6) Trustees Holmes, Norwood, Steave, Belcher, House, Brown; Clerk, Village Administrator, Atty. Raines and Vasselli, Department Heads

RESIDENT QUESTION: How come residents were denied a copy of budget today?
MAYOR HENYARD: Budget was available.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Is budget on website? Where is Village Hall? What time is the village hall open?
MAYOR HENYARD: Village Hall open from 9:00am to 5:00pm and on Monday's 9:00am – 7:00pm.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Why wasn't the budget ready today and last Friday?
MAYOR HENYARD: It was ready.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Will this budget cause a rise in property taxes?
MAYOR HENYARD: No

RESIDENT QUESTION: When was the budget available?
MAYOR HENYARD: With the public notice. You can see the clerk to get a copy of budget.
RESIDENT: The budget wasn't available when she came by.

RESIDENT QUESTION: How many new position is being presented?
MAYOR HENYARD: Several positions are being posted.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Are we going to have any increases in fees and services?
MAYOR HENYARD: No.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Do the trustees have anything to say about the budget?



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MAYOR HENYARD: Trustees will be available to speak at the special Meeting. Cris from finance can answer any questions regarding the budget.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Are we meeting today regarding a budget we didn't get it today?
MAYOR HENYARD: Budget is available tomorrow at Village Hall.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Are there new streams of revenue in the budget?
CRIS: There are no new streams of revenue.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Can you explain salaries and grants of \$150,000?
MAYOR HENYARD: Need more clarity.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Can someone name new job titles created in this budget line?
CRIS MIRCOBELLI Grant Writer and Communication Person.

RESIDENTQUESTION: Why couldn't the budget be available?
MAYOR HENYARD: The budget was available.
TRUSTEE BROWN: A resident stated the budget wasn't available.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Will the village hire or are the position already filled?
MAYOR HENYARD: Positions are posted.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Public budget should be available for 30 days.
MAYOR HENYARD: Municipal law states 10 days.
ATTY VASSELLI: 65-518-2-9 reads at least 10 days prior to appropriation.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Clerk Key, was the budget available?
CLERK KEY: I received the budget on Friday, June 18, 2021.

RESIDENT QUESTIONS: Trustees, when did you get the budget?
MAYOR HENYARD: The trustees did receive the budget. The mayor met with each department head And the trustees.

RESIDENT QUESTIONS: There is confusion regarding the budget. The Clerk stated she received it on the 18th.
CLERK KEY: I received the budget on June 18, 2021.

RESIDENT QUESTION: What is the estimate date the water bill is paid in full?
CRIS: There are multiple years left but expected to be paid in 2028.

RESIDENT QUESTIONS: Trustee House when did you receive the budget?
TRUSTEE HOUSE: I received the on June 11th and the amended budget on June 18, 2021.



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RESIDENT QUESTION: Trustee Steave, when did you receive the budget?
TRUSTEE STEAVE: I got the first budget on June 11th and amended budget on June 18, 2021.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Was there a finance committee meeting?
TRUSTEE HOUSE: There was a meeting on May 26, 2021, but we did not address the budget.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Are there new speed bumps in the budget?
MAYOR HENYARD: No new speed bumps. Police will do more enforcement.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Does Fleshman cleaning company have a contract? Does Fleshman work
For village?
MAYOR HENYARD: No to both questions.

RESIDENT QUESTION: How much is Special Events in the Mayor's budget?
CRIS: The total amount for this fiscal year is \$30,000.

RESIDENT QUESTION: How is the 90-day plan in the budget?
MAYOR HENYARD: Will be announce at the Town Hall Meeting.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Can village afford youth programs this year? Last time it was donated.
Do village have insurance?
CRIS: These are part-time positions and they do not get insurance.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Why is bonds taken out each year for Homewood Disposal?
CRIS: Village is required to get bonds to cover the expenses of Homewood Disposal.

RESIDENT QUESTION: Was cash found in the water department and was it put into an account?
MAYOR HENYARD: It was only \$20. I thought it was more.

TRUSTEE STEAVE: I would like to clear something up. I met with the village administrator to post
The budget. It should be posted by the media department. Not me. I'm not
The media person. It was up to the village administrator.
