Public Works Productivity Report for May 2021

- Public Works has installed, checked, and repaired 33 street lights and 10 street signs. Public Works has installed 2 light poles on Sibley and additionally 5 light basings have been poured for light poles to be placed.
- Public Works has cut down 28 trees and trimmed 9 trees.
- Public Works has repaired 6 B. Boxes and 2 water main breaks.
- Public Works has done restoration on 9 properties. Loader has done 40 debris pick ups.
- Public Works has repaired potholes throughout the village, street sweeper has been out on the routes.
- Public Works has checked, cleaned and repaired several sewers.
- Public Works has performed 4 emergency water turn offs.
- Public Works has cut grass and weed whipped 49 vacant properties and also vacant lots.
- Public Works Mechanics performed 1 job to the Fire Department Vehicle, 3 jobs to the Police Department Vehicles and 14 jobs to the Public Works Vehicles, along with miscellaneous jobs that have come into the shop.
